Class 1 - 09:00 - Arena 1 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

- a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.
- b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

1.00m Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00**

Class 2 - Arena 1 - Summer Bronze League Qualifier

Rule 330. Table A8. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members. Horse/rider combinations must be eligible for the league in which they are qualifying.

Competitors will be permitted to attend any four qualifiers for the semi finals and not restricted to North or South. However for the Semi-Finals members will compete in their appropriate North/South Semi-Final as defined by their registered postal address.

Qualifies for: Bronze League Semi Final.

Numbers to qualify: First 3 horse/rider combinations, disregarding those that have already qualified will qualify for their designated Bronze League Semi Final.

Riders may only qualify a maximum of four horses from the direct qualifiers and/or the league tables. Should a rider be in qualifying positions with more than four horses from both the direct qualifiers and the league tables, the rider must select which four horses they wish to take to the Semi-Final and the qualification place will be passed down the line on the league tables. Only one horse per rider is permitted to compete in the Final. Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Silver League Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS Final, riders will lose their Silver League Final place, the place will be passed down to the next highest place combination at the Semi-Final).

Only one horse per rider is permitted to compete in the Final. Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Bronze League Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS Final, riders will lose their Bronze League Final place, the place will be passed down to the next highest place combination at the Semi-Final). Should the horse qualify for the Semi Final via a Qualifier, this qualification will take precedence over the League placing. Should a horse qualify with different riders for the Bronze Semi Final – the registered owner at the qualification cut-off date will decide which Semi Final they wish the horse to compete in. The qualification will then go down the line to the next highest placed non-qualified rider at the respective qualifier being declined.

The following riders are exempt from the Bronze League Championships and finals:

- No rider will be eligible for the Bronze League Final if they have another horse in the Silver League during the respective league period. Furthermore, riders who accumulate points in the Silver League will be ineligible to participate in the Bronze League Direct Qualifiers/Semi Finals or Championship for one year (the period in which the combination move into the Silver League and the one following this).
- Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Bronze Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS final will lose their Bronze Final place)
- Any rider that has jumped on a 4* or 5* Nations Cup Team (2003 onwards) is not eligible for the Bronze League Final.
- Any riders who have been awarded FEI points within five clear calendar years prior to the year of the Championship Final
- Five results at 1.35m within a league period move the horse/rider into the Gold League for three years/six consecutive league periods.
- Result/s at 1.40m and above automatically move horse/rider into the Gold League for three years/six consecutive league periods.

Rule 290.15 - Pre-Entry Drawn Order

Entries may possibly be accepted before 9.00am providing that the number of entries are less than 60 (with the exception of County shows). Once entries reach 60 before 9.00am the class will be closed. Any entries taken on the day must compete first in the drawn order.

Prizes: 1st: £150.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £80.00, 4th: £50.00, 5th: £40.00, 6th: £40.00, Total: £460.00. **Entry Fee = £25.00**

Class 3 - Arena 1 - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £170.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 4 - Arena 1 - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/1.20m Open

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only.

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2018 are not eligible for qualification to the 2019 Championship.

Open section:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 1 - 09:00 - Arena 1 - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Newcomers:

- (a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6
- (b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £170.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 2 - Arena 1 - Summer Silver League Qualifier

Rule 331. Table A8. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members. Horse/rider combinations must be eligible for the league in which they are qualifying.

Competitors will be permitted to attend any four qualifiers for the semi finals and not restricted to North or South. However for the Semi-Finals members will compete in their appropriate North/South Semi-Final as defined by their registered postal address.

Qualifies for: Silver League Semi Final.

Numbers to qualify: First 3 horse/rider combinations, disregarding those that have already qualified will qualify for their designated Silver League Semi Final.

Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Silver League Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS Final, riders will lose their Silver League Final place, the place will be passed down to the next highest place combination at the Semi-Final).

The following riders are exempt from the Silver League Championships and finals:

- Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Silver Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS final will lose their Silver Final place)
- Any rider that has jumped on a 4* or 5* Nations Cup Team (2003 onwards) is not eligible for the Silver League Final.
- Club Members
- Any riders who have been awarded FEI points within five clear calendar years prior to the year of the Championship Final
- Five results at 1.35m within a league period move the horse/rider into the Gold League for three years/six consecutive league periods.
- Result/s at 1.40m and above automatically move horse/rider into the Gold League for three years/ six consecutive league periods.

Riders may only qualify a maximum of four horses from the direct qualifiers and/or the league tables. Should a rider be in qualifying positions with more than four horses from both the direct qualifiers and the league tables, the rider must select which four horses they wish to take to the Semi-Final and the qualification place will be passed down the line on the league tables. Only one horse per rider is permitted to compete in the Final. Any rider qualified for other Senior HOYS Final/s cannot compete in the Silver League Final in the same year (once qualified for another Senior HOYS Final, riders will lose their Silver League Final place, the place will be passed down to the next highest place combination at the Semi-Final).

Should the horse qualify for the Semi Final via a Qualifier, this qualification will take precedence over the League placing. Should a horse qualify with different riders for the Silver Semi Final – the registered owner at the

qualification cut-off date will decide which Semi Final they wish the horse to compete in. The qualification will then go down the line to the next highest placed non-qualified rider at the respective qualifier being declined.

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Foxhunter section:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2018 are not eligible for qualification to the 2019 Championship.

Open section:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00**

Class 4 - Arena 1 - National 1.30m Open

Rule 306. Single Phase. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate and Junior Members.

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

Prizes: 1st: £100.00, 2nd: £80.00, 3rd: £55.00, 4th: £40.00, 5th: £25.00, Total: £300.00. **Entry Fee = £25.00**
